

Highlights from the September Congregation Council Meeting The Council met via Zoom.

**Capital Campaign/Flat Room Project:** The Flat Roof Project started in early September. It is moving slower than anticipated due to past materials on the roof needing to be removed. The Air Conditioning unit for the 2nd floor and balcony areas was advised to not be re-installed and instead replaced. The council approved adding the \$4,000 for AC project to the Flat Roof Project.

**Worship Partnership:** When the pandemic began in Marcy, an informal partnership with the Kathryn/Nome/Fingal Parish began, as their Pastor Sharayah joined with Pastor Kyle and Pastor for online and radio broadcast services. It was noted that this has been going well and a good relationship was formed, but it seems the right time to plan an end date. At the October 24 worship service, we will give thanks for this partnership as it draws to close.

**In-Person Worship:** The State had recently moved Barnes County back into the "Yellow" risk level for Covid. Following our approved OSLC Pandemic Plan, the "Yellow" risk level means we will pause in-person worship at this time.


**Sunday School & Confirmation:** Online Sunday School registration has been happening in September. The Education Committee decided to push back the possible start date to January. Some fun/devotional items may be shared with families this fall. Confirmation will move forward as planned, with one grade meeting in person each week and an online option being available.


"Navajo Prayer" from Saying Grace: Blessings fo the Family Table

This year, I've become intrigued by the word "delight." In part, its because I've been reading "The Book of Delights" by Ross Gay. Over the course of a year, he set out to write a daily essay about something that brings him delight. The practice of writing down delights is a bit like keeping a gratitude journal -- writing down things for which you are thankful for each day. I'm convinced that we find what we are looking for. On the one hand, if we look for things that make us grumpy, we will find them. On the other hand, if we look for things that bring us delight or for which we give us thanks, we will find them.

When the prefix "de" begins a word, it means "again." I like to think about how when we delight in something, we find lightness again. Right now, so much in our world is heavy. As I write this, there are forest fires, the aftermath of a hurricane, high levels of Covid risk in our county, a church roof project that has had some hiccups, and the list goes on. We need delights to lighten the heaviness of our days: times of quiet prayer, walks in nature, a good chuckle with a friend, a delicious piece of buttered toast, and the list goes on. What is bringing you delight these days?

Have you noticed the words to the offering song as we share in online and radio service this fall? The song says, "The numberless gifts of God's mercies my tongue cannot fathom or tell...!'ll never count all of God's mercies, but oh, I can give God my praise for all of that love, my thanksgiving and love to the end of my days. I'll never count all of God's mercies, but oh, I can give God my praise!" Amidst the heaviness of our lives, God's mercies come to us anew each day.
