In the days right before Sharayah and I packed up and hit the road for California, we spent most of our time planting, weeding, watering, and preparing our garden for the summer. Our set up is a little more chaotic than most, consisting of not just flower beds and pots, but buckets, baskets, bricks, sideways bookshelves, and just about whatever we have that a flower or vegetable can grow in.

Elbow deep in dirt, I reflected on the amount of time, money, and energy we spend on our summer hobby. Sometimes when things don't work out the way that you want them, you think to yourself how much easier it would be to buy green peppers at Leever's than wait a few months for them to grow. But there's no fun in that...

Summer is the season of growth, and I don't think that has to be just for our plants. This year especially, after another long pandemic season, I have found that while I spend countless hours fending off sunburn and moths for the sake of those fresh garden veggies, I also have found some precious moments to catch my breath and to re-center myself on God's work, call, and presence all around me.

Pr. Lou Florio in an issue of *Living Lutheran* magazine, put it like this:

"We, too, grow by the grace of God. The seed of faith has been planted in our hearts, and our history, surroundings and dispositions affect us much like soil. Worse, life can be hot and dry or too stormy, threatening to wither us, outside of our control. So like the local fields, we need tending....Growth requires balance — daily rest and work centered on and fed by the love of God... Still, our shared hope remains as in Paul's long ago prayer; that all of us together may lead lives worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing to him, as we bear fruit in every good work and as we grow in the knowledge of God (Col. 1:10)."

I pray that this coming season may be one of growth for you as well, dear friends. Whether you find yourself gathered to worship from the pews or from the lake, weeding your garden, hitting the open road, or catching up on needed alone time or family time, God is there too – elbow deep in dirt – ensuring that we bloom into our fullest, most beautiful and beloved selves.
