Relationship with the Evangelical Lutheran Church of the Central African Republic (ELCCAR)


Accompaniment is relationship. This is the foundation of mission. The ELCA has relationships all over the globe, many dating from the time of its predecessor churches. These continue to be built and sustained. Each of the relationships is unique and has its joys and sorrows. That is what makes accompaniment a true relationship, similar to Jesus's own experience on the road to Emmaus in which Jesus leaves his disciples with several questions such as, "who is this man who does not know or has not heard the big news yet says he lives amongst us?"

In recent years the relationship between the ELCCAR and its partners has faced some challenges leaving both the church and partners with a lot of questions like the disciples on the road to Emmaus. But since the ELCCAR and partners have the conviction that we all are part of God's Mission, we have turned to God for answers to the many questions facing their relationship.

In March, the church and its international partners, including the ELCA, met to begin conversation on the way forward in this important relationship. Due to the pandemic international partners couldn't travel to CAR, but also because of the digital gap a virtual meeting from CAR was hard to arrange. The newly elected president and vice president of the ELCCAR had to travel from Bouar in CAR to Yaounde in Cameroon to access better internet connections for the meetings. The trip also opened opportunities to connect with the three ELCA companion synods (Texas-Louisiana Gulf Coast, Eastern North Dakota and Western North Dakota), the Lutheran World Federation Africa region and the Lutheran Office for World Community (LOWC-our ELCA colleagues at the UN in New York).

We ask prayers for the church in CAR and its partners as the ELCCAR seeks to serve God's people in a very challenging situation.

Dear People of Our Savior's Lutheran Church,

After years of planning and dreaming, the moment is finally upon us. On Sunday, October 3rd, we will take our first steps in a bold 3 year capital appeal. To say this process will be a leap of faith is an understatement. I wish I could see into the future and let you all know how this adventure will play out, but I can't. Instead, I find myself praying the words of one of my favorite hymns:
