Missionary Calendar

The 2021 Missionary Calendar is located above the information counter. Donations of \$25 a day support our missionaries, Willie and Anne Langdji, serving as ELCA Representatives in Western Africa. They provide support to churches, schools, and medical centers in that region, including our partner synod in the Central African Republic. Donations also support Global Health Ministries, a Twin Cities based organization that supports medical centers around the world, through shipping supplies, sharing expertise.





In March, Global Health Ministries sent a 40' container to Cameroon and the Central African Republic! The container sends medical equipment and supplies to 4 hospitals, 24 health centers, a dental clinic, and an eye clinic in Cameroon, and Emmanuel and Bohong Health Centers in CAR. So many important items, including a new surgical table for Ngaoundere Protestant Hospital, 21 hospital beds and mattresses, a refurbished, anesthesia gas machine, and Hospice Kits, Newborn Kits and Rolled Bandages.



Second Corinthians offers a real-life window on a strained relationship between a church leader and the people whom he loves. In this letter, we see an anxious apostle hoping to restore the relationship he had with churches he founded, even as he tries to avoid being drawn into a contest with other teachers over who has the most impressive skills and credentials. To do this, he discloses much about his own devotion to the Corinthians, his hardships in ministry, and the reconciliation God has accomplished for them all in Christ.

As I write this, news stories and social media posts remind me that we have lived in this pandemic season for more than 365 days. My strength is no accident. It was planted deep in my rich soil long before I thought to need it.

This life has already stretched me until sore muscles tore.

I have been made to feel so small I almost disappeared.

Almost.

But I keep rising toward the sunshine. I am deep roots and sharp thorns and wide leaves catching light.

I hope on to this slope where rocks slide, the earth corrodes, seasons change, but I remain. I take up space against all odds. The stubborn, savage beauty of one who will not fade away.
