On Easter morning we sang together, "Walking the way, Christ in the center telling the story to open our eyes; breaking our bread, giving us glory: <u>Jesus our blessing</u>, <u>our constant surprise</u>. Jesus is risen and we shall arise. Give God the glory! Alleluia! (ELW #377)

Our scriptures are filled with stories of SURPRISE. An old and childless Sarah, is surprised to find out that she is pregnant. Joseph, who had been betrayed by his brothers, surprises them with forgiveness. Of all of Jesse's son, the youngest David is surprised to be selected to be a leader and king. Jesus surprises Zacchaeus by inviting him to his house. Mary and Martha are surprised when Jesus raised their brother Lazarus from the death. Of course, at Easter we celebrate the big surprise: the women are surprised to find that the tomb is empty. Jesus is Risen! Death shall have no say over us. Love and life wins!

Though Jesus Christ remains the same yesterday, today, and forever, yet through the leading of the Holy Spirit, God continues to surprise us with grace, doing a new thing among us. The Book of Acts tells how the Holy Spirit was at work in the early church. As people tried to figure out what it meant to be followers of Jesus after the resurrection, the Holy Spirit surprised them. God's grace was bigger than what they sometimes expected. The power of God's Spirit in their lives sometimes surprised them to go in new directions.

Pastor Kyle and I are excited to explore some of these surprising stories from the Book of Acts with you on Sunday mornings during this Easter Season. We pray that these stories will awaken us to how God continues to be at work in our lives and this world today. Maybe, there will even be a few surprises on Sunday mornings!

Perhaps one way we can further live into this surprising Easter season is to bring surprises into this world. In the midst of a time of great fear, we can surprise people with grace. Pay for a stranger's coffee. Drop off flowers at a neighbor's door. Practice "scruffy" hospitality; invite a friend over for a meal even if the food or house isn't perfect. Leave a \$5 bill for someone to find. You get the idea. Have fun living in the love of God in Christ Jesus. I'd love to hear about your adventures in surprises.

Finally, a word of reminder: As your pastors, Pastor Kyle and I are available to share in conversation and prayer with you. None of us needs to journey through the joys and hardships of this life alone. God surrounds us with all sorts of people to journey together. If you'd value a conversation with one of us or for us to bring you Holy Communion, please do reach out. We want to be available to you in ways that you might need.




