#### **Notes From Your Treasurer\$\$**

As I am writing this message the middle of October for the November newsletter, I'm reviewing our finances from the end of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter. We are on target with a lot of our commitments: Eastern ND Synod, Missionary Sponsorship, Red Willow Ministries, Sheyenne Valley Chaplaincy, Lutheran Immigration, and our Deferred Maintenance in the Building Fund. I've also made monthly payments this year on the parsonage loan, which now has a balance of \$43,847.04.

The Capital Campaign (Growing in Grace) has been able to move forward on projects with the gifts our congregation has given (often depending on supplies and workforce for the different projects.) Take time to thank the members of the Property Committee for their diligence in taking care of not only projects/repairs at our church, but also projects and repairs at our two parsonages.

If you are looking for a place to give a special gift, OSLC has committed to giving Global Health Missions \$4,000 before December 31. Global Health Missions focuses on health care which includes providing medical equipment and supplies and community-based primary health care programs all over the world. **Special Guest**, Rev. Brad Skogen, Associate with the Bishop for Congregational Leadership and Transition, led discussion and shared conversation about the call process with the council. A group from council will work on compiling a Ministry Site Profile (MSP) to be used in the call process of an additional called staff member. Opportunities for interim ministry will be addressed following the council's recommendation of a new staffing model and/or the senior pastor opening.

**Capital Projects:** Finishing touches are being made on the metal roofing project over the sanctuary. Damages to inside sanctuary roof caused by installation are currently being addressed. Installation of north lower level and apartment level windows about 50% complete, estimated to be done in the next week. New carpet and paint project for Gathering Room also nearing a start date.

**Custodial Position:** The council shared its gratitude for Sandi Ley, who will end her time as Custodian for OSLC on October 31<sup>st</sup>. In conjunction with the property committee, the council will publicize the job opening inside and outside the congregation. The custodial job description was updated, and the council discussed the possible need of temporary custodial coverage from a cleaning service.

**OSLC Constitution and Committee Charters:** The council was presented the final draft of new committee charters that had been reviewed and crafted over the course of several months, recommending a shift from 8 committees to 6. This change in committee structure, as well as required additions to the OSLC Constitution, will be addressed at a congregational meeting set for Sunday, November 20<sup>th</sup> at 9:35 a.m.

**Call Committee/Call Process:** The Council nominated present members to serve as a call committee to consider Pr. Kyle for the senior pastor opening. The group will meet over the next coming weeks and will make a recommendation to the council. A call vote will be held at a congregational meeting set for Sunday, November 20<sup>th</sup> at 9:35 a.m.

**Congregational Meeting:** A Congregational Meeting was set for Sunday, November 20<sup>th</sup> at 9:35 a.m. to address updates to the OSLC Constitution and Committee structures, as well as for a call vote for the senior pastor opening.
