

"In religious buildings, such as churches and synagogues, donors gave gifts to their community. But when they gave, they made it clear that they gave also – indeed primarily – to God. In [the years] 244-245 the leaders of the Jewish community at Dura Europos (on the Euphrates in modern Syria) placed their names on a row of tile on the ceiling of their great, newly frescoed synagogue. Over twenty feet above the floor, they could barely read by the congregation. Rather, these inscriptions were intended for the eyes of God alone."

Together with those generations before who met the challenges of their time, we are called to continue being a living hope for generations today and those still to come."

God has a dream for Our Savior's and Valley City to be a center for mission and ministry for generations to come, and *together* we are working to make that dream a reality. Thank you for all the ways you continue to grow in grace, gratitude, and generosity for the glory of God.

Below is an overview of our 2023 worship survey results as presented to the church council on May 10<sup>th</sup>.

Total Respondents: 102 (Answers and Comments were anonymous)

Q: How long have you been a member at OSLC? A: 10+ yrs. (79.6%), 4-9 yrs. (13.3%), 1-3 yrs. (6.1%), <1 yr. (1%)

*Q: Typically attended service?* A: 8:30a (48%), 10:30a (29.6%), Both (18.4%), Online/Digital (22.4%)

Q: I like having more than one service option? A: All the Time (27.4%), Most of the Time (21.1%), Some of the Time (22.1%), Rarely (25.3%), Never (6.3%)

Q: Prefer Traditional Worship? A: All the Time (22.9%), Most of the Time (40.6%), Some of the Time (29.2%)

Q: Prefer Contemporary Worship? A: All the Time (12.5%), Most of the Time (13.5%), Some of the Time (49%), Rarely or Never (27.1%)

*Q: I wish we could have a blended service*? **A: All the** Time (23.7%), Most of the Time (22.7%), Some of the Time (37.1%)

*Q: I'd attend on a day other than Sunday?* **A: Some of the Time, Rarely, or Never (83.3%)** 

*Q: I wish we only had 1 service on Sunday?* **A: All the** Time (17.4%), Most of the Time (15.1%), Some of the Time (23.3%), Rarely (19.8%), Never (24.4%)



**Growing in Grace Projects:** Updates on ongoing and upcoming projects were given. Approval for the completion of the west steps project were given. During the July meeting, the council will do a mid-appeal review of ongoing projects and the Growing in Grace Fund.

My garage: It looks a lot like it looked before -minus three boxes! Happy Spring-Happy Summer!!


