





The *Instant Church Directory* program will allow us to publish the familiar hard copy directories, but also allows to share our directory through our website and a user-friendly app. More importantly than ever before, individuals and families will have the ability to edit information directly and instantly so that family pictures, phone numbers, emails, and addresses can always be up-to-date.

The directory is up and running now, and all we need now is for you to update your information!

This month, you are encouraged do to one of three things...

More detailed instructions for accessing and using the *Instant Church Directory* program can be found on the directory table at the church. Additionally, Council members will be manning a help desk every Sunday in September, beginning the 8th, to help you navigate this new program and to answer your questions. We'll also have walk throughs during worship on Sunday and shared on our Facebook page.

For those who choose digital access to the Directory, once you are signed up, you will have full access right away! For those who would prefer a hard copy version, we anticipate booklets to be available sometime in November. In the meantime, we are excited to get the ball rolling on this first step in our re-connection commitment.

I'm writing this message today in the middle of August, looking at the calendar and realizing how quickly August is slipping away, and how soon we will be sliding into September.

To me September is a changing of the seasons: the season of vacations, summer sports, family reunions is ending and the season of school, school sports, cleaning up gardens, harvest is upon us.

I would be remiss if I didn't report on our finances at Our Saviors. There is a history of the slackness in our giving during the summer months. At the end of July, 2024 our General Fund expenses were \$37,467 more than our income. At the end of July in 2023 the giving was actually \$32,569 more than the expenses. I realize that this year we have more people on staff. I am hoping that the last half of 2024 will see a substantial increase in the giving.

Please enjoy the remainder of the summer and as we fall into our autumn routines, let us be thankful for each day God gives us. I appreciate all the ways you support me and my work for Our Saviors!
